

## **School Based Immunisation Program**

### **What to do when a year 7 student comes to your practice!**

Currently the WA year 7 school vaccination program is provided by community health nurses and some local councils who will visit the children at school to offer the age appropriate free vaccinations.



If a parent chooses to have their child vaccinated at your practice there is a clear and easy practical process to follow:

1. Ring your local RIC (Regional Immunisation Coordinator) to order vaccines specific to the child's needs;
2. The RIC will forward you the appropriate paperwork that needs to be completed so the school vaccination database can be updated with that child's information;
3. Vaccinate child;
4. Return form Govt. form as recommended.
